Whereas, “expert” opinion offered on behalf of plaintiffs may not represent truth regarding the standard of care or even their own personal practice.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the NH Medical Society supports the development of legislation which would make it a criminal offense to misrepresent the standard of care.
